



# Sunkist Country Club

## Rules & Policies

*Member • Guest • Facility Guidelines*

---

Sunkist Country Club strives to provide an enjoyable and welcoming golf experience for members, guests, and visitors. These policies are designed to protect the condition of the golf course, support the operation of the club, and promote a safe and respectful environment for everyone who enjoys the facility. The following guidelines help ensure that Sunkist Country Club remains a place where great golf and great company come together.

## **Article I — Management Authority & Conduct**

---

### **1.1 Management Authority**

The General Manager and designated club staff are responsible for the interpretation and enforcement of all club policies.

Club staff, including golf shop personnel, starters, marshals, and food and beverage staff, are authorized to enforce these policies to ensure a safe and enjoyable environment for everyone at the club.

Management reserves the right to interpret, enforce, or modify these policies as necessary for the orderly operation of the club.

### **1.2 Conduct Expectations**

Sunkist Country Club expects all members, guests, and visitors to treat one another and club staff with respect and courtesy.

Disruptive, abusive, or inappropriate behavior toward other individuals or club staff will not be tolerated.

### **1.3 Staff Authority**

All club employees are empowered to enforce club policies as necessary to protect the operation of the club and the experience of those enjoying the facility. This includes golf shop staff, starters, marshals, and food and beverage staff.

Players and guests should not attempt to enforce club policies or confront other groups directly. Any concerns regarding pace of play, course behavior, or other issues should be directed to club staff.

### **1.4 Removal from Property**

Management reserves the right to ask any individual to leave the property if their behavior is disruptive, unsafe, or in violation of club policies.

Individuals who refuse to comply with such requests may be subject to removal from the property with the assistance of local law enforcement if necessary.

## **Article II — Golf Course Policies**

---

### **2.1 Pace of Play**

Sunkist Country Club maintains a target pace of play of four hours for 18 holes.

Players are expected to maintain pace with the group ahead and play without undue delay. Groups unable to maintain pace may be asked to allow faster groups to play through or skip forward to regain position.

### **2.2 Golf Cart Policy**

Golf carts must be operated responsibly and in accordance with course conditions and any instructions provided by club staff.

Under normal conditions, carts should follow the 90-degree rule when entering the fairway.

To protect the golf course, carts must remain on cart paths:

- Around all greens
- Around all tee boxes
- On all par 3 holes

Management will determine cart restrictions daily based on course conditions. During periods of wet conditions or when necessary to protect the golf course, the course may be designated cart path only.

Players are responsible for the safe operation of golf carts at all times.

### **2.3 Walking Policy**

Walking is permitted at Sunkist Country Club provided players maintain the expected pace of play. Players choosing to walk should remain aware of surrounding groups and keep pace with those using carts.

### **2.4 Starter & Marshal Authority**

The starter and course marshals are responsible for assisting with pace of play and ensuring adherence to club policies. Players are expected to follow the directions of the starter and marshals while on the golf course.

## **Article III — Practice Facilities**

---

### **3.1 General Practice Facility Use**

Sunkist Country Club offers practice facilities including a driving range, multiple short game areas, and putting greens.

Practice facilities are open to the public. However, all players must check in with the golf shop or starter prior to using the practice facilities. This policy helps ensure proper facility use and allows staff to manage practice activity throughout the day.

### **3.2 Driving Range**

The driving range is maintained regularly to ensure quality practice conditions.

- The driving range is clean picked every Tuesday to allow mowing on Wednesday mornings
- During the growing season, the driving range will close at 5:30 PM on Tuesdays for maintenance
- During PGA Jr. League season, the driving range will be closed on Thursdays from 4:00 PM to 5:30 PM for team practice

Players are encouraged to contact the golf shop for seasonal schedules or range availability.

### **3.3 Range Ball Policy**

Range balls are provided for use on the driving range only.

- Range balls are not permitted on the golf course
- Range balls are not permitted in short game practice areas
- Players should practice around the greens using their own golf balls

Using personal golf balls for short game practice helps simulate real on-course conditions.

### **3.4 Range Ball Distribution**

Range balls are distributed through the golf shop using the following system:

- Range balls are placed in practice crates until 1:00 PM daily
- After 1:00 PM, players must obtain range tokens from the golf shop

This policy ensures all players properly check in before using the practice facilities.

### **3.5 Short Game Practice Areas**

Sunkist Country Club maintains multiple short game areas for chipping, pitching, and bunker practice. Players using these areas should:

- Practice with their own golf balls
- Respect other players using the facility

- Limit practice time during busy periods

Range balls are not permitted in short game practice areas.

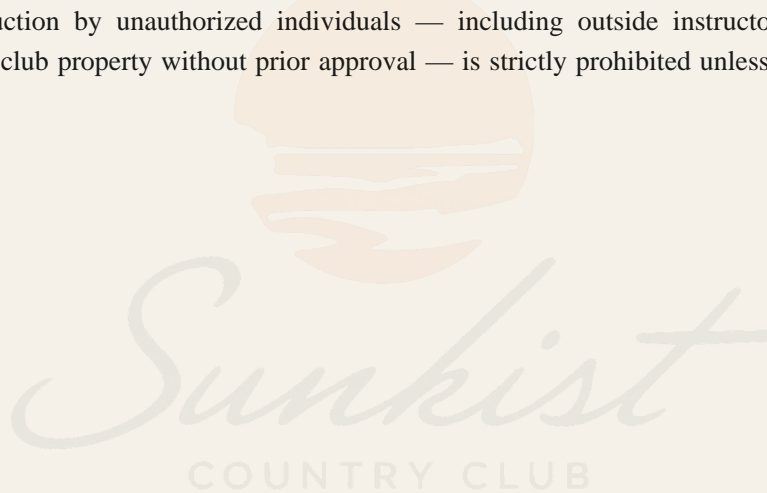
### **3.6 Instruction & Fittings**

Sunkist Country Club offers professional instruction and club fitting services. Instruction opportunities may include:

- Private lessons
- Group instruction
- Junior clinics
- Equipment fitting days

Instruction is provided by PGA Coaches certified in teaching and performance training.

Golf instruction on club property may only be provided by teaching professionals authorized by Sunkist Country Club. Instruction by unauthorized individuals — including outside instructors or any individual providing lessons on club property without prior approval — is strictly prohibited unless expressly authorized by management.



## **Article IV — Course Care & Etiquette**

---

### **4.1 Course Care**

All players are expected to help maintain the condition of the golf course by practicing proper golf etiquette. Players should:

- Repair ball marks on greens
- Replace or fill divots
- Rake bunkers after use
- Dispose of trash in appropriate receptacles

Maintaining the condition of the golf course is a shared responsibility of all players.

### **4.2 Music & Speakers**

Music may be played on the golf course provided it is kept at a reasonable volume that does not disturb other players.

Music should only be audible to the group playing it. Players should be mindful that other groups on the course should not be able to hear their music.

Club staff may request that music be lowered or turned off if it becomes disruptive to other players.

### **4.3 Outside Coolers & Alcohol**

Outside alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited anywhere on club property.

Outside coolers are not permitted on club property unless necessary for medical reasons.

Club staff reserve the right to inspect coolers or bags brought onto the property to ensure compliance with this policy.

Food and beverages are available through the clubhouse and beverage cart for player convenience.

## **Article V — Guest & Public Play**

---

### **5.1 Public Play**

Sunkist Country Club operates as a semi-private golf facility welcoming members, loyalty card holders, guests, and public play.

Tee times may be reserved by the public based on availability. Certain time periods may be reserved for members, loyalty card holders, tournaments, or club events.

Management reserves the right to adjust public booking availability as needed for club operations.

### **5.2 Guests**

Members and loyalty card holders are welcome to invite guests to enjoy the golf course.

Guests must be accompanied by a member or loyalty card holder in order to receive the applicable guest rate.

Guests who are not accompanied by a member or loyalty card holder will be charged the applicable public rate.

### **5.3 Loyalty Card Program**

Sunkist Country Club offers a loyalty card program designed to reward frequent players.

Loyalty card holders receive preferred pricing and may invite guests to receive the applicable guest rate when playing together.

Participation in the loyalty program does not constitute club membership and does not include membership privileges unless otherwise specified.

## **Article VI — Alcohol Policy**

---

Sunkist Country Club is licensed to sell alcoholic beverages through its bar and grill. All alcoholic beverages consumed on the premises must be purchased from the club.

The possession or consumption of outside alcohol anywhere on club property is strictly prohibited.

Outside alcohol is not permitted on the golf course, in golf carts, in the clubhouse, or in parking areas.

Individuals found with outside alcohol will be asked to remove it from the property or return it to their vehicle.

Failure to comply with this policy may result in the individual being asked to leave the property at the discretion of management.



## **Article VII — Dress Code**

---

### **Golf Course & Practice Facilities**

Sunkist Country Club maintains a moderate dress code intended to promote a comfortable and respectful golf environment. Appropriate golf attire is required on the golf course and practice facilities.

#### **Men's Attire**

- Collared shirts are required
- Mock neck shirts and golf-specific athletic wear are permitted
- Denim and clean athletic shorts are allowed
- Denim must be in good taste and free of rips, holes, or excessive wear
- T-shirts are not permitted on the golf course or practice facilities

#### **Women's Attire**

- Golf-specific tops, skirts, shorts, leggings, and denim are permitted
- Denim must be in good taste and free of rips, holes, or excessive wear
- Spaghetti strap tops are not permitted
- Clothing that is excessively revealing is not permitted

Management reserves the right to determine whether attire is appropriate for the golf environment.

#### **Clubhouse & Bar Area**

The clubhouse and bar area maintain a relaxed atmosphere while still encouraging clean and presentable attire.

- Golf attire is preferred
- Clean casual attire is permitted
- Shirts and shoes are required at all times

## **Article VIII — Junior Golf**

---

### **8.1 Junior Play**

Junior golfers are welcome at Sunkist Country Club and are encouraged to enjoy the game in a respectful and responsible manner.

Juniors 12 years of age and under must be accompanied by an adult while on the golf course unless otherwise approved by management.

### **8.2 Junior Access to the Golf Course**

To help maintain pace of play during peak hours, junior golfers are not permitted to play the golf course before 2:00 PM on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays without adult supervision unless otherwise approved by management.

### **8.3 Golf Cart Policy for Juniors**

Junior golfers may walk the golf course or ride in a golf cart with a licensed driver.

Golf carts may only be operated by individuals who possess a valid driver's license.

### **8.4 Junior Conduct**

Junior golfers are expected to follow all club policies and practice proper golf etiquette while on the property.

Club staff reserve the right to address behavior or pace-of-play issues involving junior golfers as necessary to maintain an enjoyable environment for all players.
